Whereas, in 2015, Bill embarked on a new career at Bank of New York, where he led the Legal Department practice groups focused on government affairs, public policy, regulatory affairs, and corporate services legal functions;

Whereas, Bill has written numerous articles and spoken on many educational panels;

Whereas, Bill has been a Fellow of the American College of Bankruptcy since 1996, was a Regent at Large for four years and served with great distinction as its General Counsel for 20 years;

Whereas, he has been a member of the American Law Institute, a director of the American Bankruptcy Institute, a member of the Business Bankruptcy Committee of the American Bar Association, a member of the Board of Directors of the D.C. Neighborhood Legal Services Program, and Trustee of Union College while serving as General Counsel to the Board of Trustees;

Whereas, throughout his career, Bill has been a friend, mentor, and colleague to a vast number of professionals in all areas of practice;

Whereas, through his scholarship, judgment, integrity, humanity, service and professionalism, Bill has embodied the highest ideals of the legal profession for over 45 years;
